1911 Gold Corporation is seeking a skilled and safety-focused **Mechanical Supervisor** is responsible for leading the maintenance, repair, and reliability of both surface and underground mobile equipment. This role provides leadership to the mechanical team, ensuring work is completed safely, efficiently, and in alignment with operational requirements. The successful candidate will demonstrate strong leadership, technical expertise, and a commitment to safety, while supporting team development and contractor management.

The Mechanical Supervisor will work collaboratively with maintenance teams and other trades to minimize downtime, ensure compliance with codes and regulations, and support safe, efficient production operations.

Key Responsibilities

Mechanical Maintenance & Operations

- Oversee the maintenance, repair, upgrade, and install mechanical systems and equipment, including LHD equipment, electric /Hydraulic drills, pneumatic drilling equipment, underground electric locomotives and personnel vehicles.
- Collaborates with other teams and supervisors.
- Inspect and ensure all mechanical equipment meets applicable regulations and codes
- Identify, evaluate and control mechanical risks in the field, implementing corrective and preventive actions.

- Ensure the correct recording of activities in the computerized maintenance management system (CMMS).
- Recommend improvements to maximize maintenance efficiency and minimize operational downtime.
- Ensure that personnel have the required training, competencies, and authorizations.

Leadership & Supervision

- Lead and coordinate the team of mechanical teams and apprentices, including task assignment and prioritization.
- Promote a strong safety culture and ensure compliance with all 1911 Gold and regulatory requirements
- Coach, mentor, and develop apprentices and less experienced team members
- Support team building and foster a collaborative work environment

Contractor Management

- Maintains effective working relationships with Contractors, Suppliers and Service Providers, and ensures adherence to contractual requirements.
- Manage contractor performance and ensure work meets company standards
- Coordinate work schedules and priorities across crews
- Ensure proper documentation and reporting of maintenance activities
