Position Overview

1911 Gold is currently seeking two Site Services Operators to support the safe, reliable, and efficient operation of surface infrastructure and site services across the property. This role performs a broad range of hands-on duties, including material handling, infrastructure upkeep, road and grounds maintenance, fuel monitoring, and coordination with internal departments and external vendors.

The Site Services Operator plays an important role in maintaining site functionality to support mining, milling, camp, and general site operations.

Key Responsibilities

Site Services Operations

- Operate and monitor site services systems and equipment, including:
 - Potable and raw water systems
 - Sewage and wastewater treatment systems
 - Waste handling and disposal infrastructure
 - Light surface and support equipment such as trucks, loaders, and skid steers
- Complete routine inspections, basic maintenance, minor repairs, and general infrastructure repairs as directed

Material Handling and Logistics

- Complete material deliveries to the mill, headframe, and other site locations as required
- Receive incoming freight and verify Bill of Lading documentation when warehouse staff are unavailable or require additional support
- Forward Bill of Lading receipts to the procurement and warehousing teams promptly
- Coordinate with warehouse personnel to support timely movement and tracking of materials

Fuel and Waste Management

- Conduct fuel tank dips and accurately report measurements to the Warehouse department
- Monitor fuel and site consumables and report shortages or anomalies
- Notify responsible vendors when refuse bins are full and arrange replacement with empty bins
- Support waste sorting, recycling, and disposal activities in accordance with environmental requirements

Roads, Walkways, and Grounds Maintenance

- Maintain site roads, walkways, and access routes as required or instructed
- Perform grading, snow removal, sanding, and general grounds upkeep
- Maintain access roads to and from the Tailings Pond to support safe travel conditions
- Identify, report, and repair road, drainage, or infrastructure issues that may impact safety or operations

Safety, Environmental, and Compliance

- Follow 1911 Gold health, safety, environmental, and operational standards at all times
- Complete pre-operational inspections, FLHAs, and assigned safety documentation
- Identify hazards, report near misses, and correct unsafe conditions where possible
- Ensure work activities comply with applicable regulatory, environmental, and company requirements

Communication and Reporting

- Communicate effectively with the Site Services Lead Hand, Department Superintendent, and other departments
- Complete shift logs, inspection forms, and work orders accurately and on time
- Report equipment issues, infrastructure concerns, and vendor coordination needs promptly

Qualifications and Experience

The successful candidates will bring hands-on experience in site services, surface operations, equipment operation, maintenance, construction, public works, or a related field.

Experience operating light surface equipment such as loaders, skid steers, plow trucks, or similar equipment is considered an asset.
