1911 Gold Corporation is seeking a Senior Underground Mine Geologist to support the mine development and mine operation activities at the True North Project in Bissett, Manitoba.

Reporting to the Company's Department Head, the Senior Underground Mine Geologist is responsible for the leadership and direction in all underground geological activities related to the development of the project. The successful candidate will be responsible for the leadership and direction of the mine geology group, and establishing, managing, and prioritizing activities to achieve short term and strategic goals of the operation while maximizing the recovery of the reserve and identifying any new resources to be converted into reserves. Specific areas of oversight include face and muck sampling for ore control, resource definition and exploration drilling, geological interpretation, short range modeling, geologic database, month end reporting, and reconciliation. The Senior Underground Mine Geologist will show strong leadership and work ethic while maintaining a strong commitment to safety and operational excellence.

### Key Responsibilities

#### Grade Control & Ore Delineation

- Conduct underground mapping, sampling, and geological interpretation
- Perform grade control activities, including face sampling and channel sampling
- Identify ore boundaries and communicate changes to Mine Operations Department
- Support dilution control and ore recovery optimization

#### Geological Data & Reporting

- Ensure accurate and timely collection and entry of geological data
- Maintain and update geological models and databases
- Support reconciliation of mined versus predicted ore
- Prepare daily, weekly, and monthly geological reports

### **Underground Support & Coordination**

- Work closely with Mine Operations to provide real-time geological guidance
- Communicate geological risks and opportunities to direct Supervisor, Engineering and Mine Operation teams
- Support short- and long-term mine planning with geological input
